



TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Deposit and Final Payment

A deposit of \$800 per person is required at time of booking. Full payment is due 60 days prior to departure.

Cancellation

We rely on your attendance to make important arrangements, so if for any reason you need to cancel prior to the start date a refund less an administrative fee will be determined on a case by case basis. COUSINS PHOTO TOURS, LLC reserves the right to cancel a reservation if full payment has not been received by 30 days before the start of the photo tour. COUSINS PHOTO TOURS, LLC is not responsible for cancellations due to medical emergencies.

We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance. In the event that a tour must be cancelled due to inadequate enrollment, all fees and deposits are refunded in full or may be transferred to another tour within 12 months.

COUSINS PHOTO TOURS, LLC is not responsible for reimbursement of non-refundable airline tickets in the event of a photo tour cancellation. Please check on the photo tour status prior to making travel arrangements.

Notification by phone or email is acceptable, but please follow with written notice. In the unlikely event we have to cancel a tour, a full refund will be given.

Tour Price

Cost includes ground transport listed on itinerary, hotel accommodations, guides, breakfasts and some other meals indicated on itinerary. Price does not include passport fees, airport taxes, baggage or portage fees, flight/trip insurance, individual transfers, tips, personal expenses such as telephone, laundry, beverages and other expenses not shown as included. Individual tips to local guides are always welcome.

All prices of tours are quoted in U.S. dollars and are based on exchange rates effective at time of printing. A small group surcharge may be added in the event that the group size is under the minimum number of passengers (usually eight depending on the tour). No refunds can be claimed for unused portions of the tour, including meals, due to personal reasons and voluntary changes.

Responsibility

COUSINS PHOTO TOURS, LLC, and/or their agents give notice that all arrangements for the transportation and conveyance for hotel accommodations made by them are as agents ONLY. Upon the express condition that they shall not be liable for any theft, injury, damage, loss, accident, defects in any vehicle or through acts of default of the Company or persons engaged in conveying the passengers or in carrying out the arrangements of the tour, or otherwise in connection therewith or for any hotel/guest house proprietor or

employee. COUSINS PHOTO TOURS, LLC and/or their agents can accept no responsibility for losses or accidental expenses due to delay or changes in airline or other means of transport schedule, hotel over booking or default, sickness, weather, strikes, war, quarantine or other uncontrollable causes. All such losses or expenses will have to be borne by the passenger. The right is reserved to cancel or to alter the tour.

Health

This trip is not strenuous and anyone who is reasonably fit should be able to take part in most of the activities. You may experience general fatigue due to the long flights and the change in time zones. You need to be able to carry and manage your own equipment. Some hotels may not have elevators.

You should also be aware that medical services or facilities might not be readily available during all or part of your trip. This could include emergency medical care, presence of physicians, or adequate medication.

It is the responsibility of each tour member to inform the tour operator of any possible health problems or handicaps upon registration. By forwarding a signed reservation form and trip deposit, you certify that you do not knowingly have any physical or other conditions of disability that would create a risk for you or other trip participants. Once a trip has been confirmed, medical circumstances will not be considered as exceptions to our cancellation policy. We assume no responsibility for medical care or for special dietary requirements.

Inoculations

Please consult your local public health or travel health clinic for any inoculations required for the country you will be visiting.

Itinerary

While COUSINS PHOTO TOURS, LLC strives to make the itinerary as accurate as possible, it should be considered as an approximate schedule of activities rather than a rigid schedule of events. Trip itineraries are subject to revision due to weather, ocean or trail conditions, government restrictions, and other reasons beyond our control. The tour leader has the right to make changes in the published itinerary whenever in his sole judgment conditions warrant, or if he deems it necessary for the comfort or safety of the tour.

Passport/Visa

A valid passport with two blank pages and at least six months validity remaining is required of each passenger. Visa fees are not included in the tour and Visa's must be obtained individually.

Baggage

Check with individual airlines for baggage requirements, weight limits and charges. All baggage, including portorage, is the individual's responsibility and may incur additional charges. International airlines allow two pieces of checked baggage per traveler with combined dimensions not to exceed 107" and one piece of carry-on baggage (although two pieces are usually accommodated).

Insurance

Each participant must be covered by medical insurance that is valid overseas. We strongly urge you to evaluate your risk and to take out insurance on your trip. It is vital for you to realize that if you experience a delay or find it necessary to cancel or cut short your trip for any reason, you will lose part or the entire sum you've invested.

Travel insurance helps to minimize the risk of monetary losses you would incur in the event of a delay of your departure due to weather, airline strike, missed connection, etc., your inability to travel for reasons such as illness, injury, unforeseen financial complications and other personal circumstances, or if you were required to cut your trip short for medical or any other reasons.

There are restrictions and limitations on any insurance program. For this reason, choose your insurance carefully. Check their policies regarding trip cancellation, baggage, and medical insurance. It is to your advantage to apply for insurance at the earliest possible time, so don't delay in making a decision.
